Lotherton Hall – Thursday 21st May 2026

We have planned to take the children in Reception on a visit to Lotherton Hall to enhance our topic 'Amazing Animals'. The children will take part in a woodland hunt workshop looking at the animals that live within the woods.

We will travel there and back by a coach. We will be setting off at 8:30am prompt so I would appreciate it if your child could be at the classroom door for **8:15am**. We will then set off at 14:00 to arrive back at school for around 15:45.

If you are able to accompany us on this trip, please speak to one of the Reception team. There are a limited number of places available on the coach.

As children in Reception are in receipt of Universal Free School Meals, the school kitchen can provide a grab bag style packed (sandwich, fruit, bun/flap jack, juice carton) or you can provide your own.
