Dear Parent/Carer,

Lotherton Hall – Thursday 21st May 2026

We have planned to take the children in Year 4 on a visit to Lotherton Hall to enhance our work on World War II. This trip will enable your child to experience a unique insight into life as an evacuee in the Second World War.

We will travel there and back by a coach. We will be setting off at 8:20am prompt so I would appreciate it if your child could be lined up in the playground at **8:10am**. We will attend a workshop in the morning with a range of activities linked to evacuees. In the afternoon, we will explore the grounds of Lotherton Hall and the wildlife world. We will then set off at 14:00 to arrive back at school for around 15:45.

Please can you ensure your child has a **packed lunch, extra snack and drink**.

The day is designed for the children to dress in the style of a child who is about to be evacuated. Please can you support your child to come dressed in this style, I have attached some pictures to help below.

The cost of this trip is **£14.25** per child (see breakdown below)

- Museum Entry & Workshop/s - £135.00
 - Transport Costs - £292.50
- Total Costs: £427.50

Divided by 30 children = **£14.25 per child**

Consent/contribution is via Arbor. Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Consent/contribution deadline is **Thursday 14th May 2026**.
